## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Ms. Belva Buck has been dually enrolled with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Belva Buck wishes to remain on the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and relinquish her membership with the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Belva Buck has signed a conditional relinquishment with the San Carlos Apache Tribe on March 5, 1996; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds that Belva Buck, whose birth date is September 9, 1963, possesses a blood quantum of one-half White Mountain Apache and one-half total Indian Blood; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds that Belva Buck meets the blood quantum requirements set forth in the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, while Belva Buck was enrolled with the San Carlos Apache Tribe she received a per-capita distribution under Court of Claims Docket 22-H; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 04-96-085, which has been incorporated into the Tribe's 22-H Distribution Plan, Belva Buck would be ineligible to receive a distribution under the White Mountain Apache Tribe's judgement under its Court of Claims Case 22-H.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Belva Buck's request and reaffirms her membership in the White Mountain Apache Tribe based upon the recommendation of the Enrollment Committee and subject to rescission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code Section 1-202 © and 1-704, and subject to the final execution of her conditional relinquishment of membership from the San Carlos Apache Tribe.

## Resolution No. <u>06-97-179</u>

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that pursuant to Resolution No. 04-96-085 and the Tribe's 22-H Distribution Plan, Belva Buck shall be ineligible to receive a distribution under Court of Claims Case Docket 22-H, due to Belva Buck's prior receipt of Docket 22-H funds while enrolled with the San Carlos Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 27, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
