

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted resolution 08-97-211 on August 6, 1997 directing that Tribal Member Patricia Nosie be reinstated to a position available within the Tribal Prosecution Unit; and


WHEREAS, Tribal Council Member Margaret Walker who sponsored Resolution 08-97-211 wishes to introduce a motion to rescind said resolution based upon further investigation of the circumstances giving rise to Ms. Nosie's resignation from the probationary position and of Ms. Nosie's conviction in the White Mountain Tribal Court for criminal negligence involving the beating of a minor, and further to maintain public confidence in the office of the Tribal Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS the Tribal Council after considerable discussion of the circumstances of the resignation and having obtained a clarification of the Tribal Court proceedings and conviction, concludes that reinstatement Resolution 08-97-211 should be rescinded.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution 08-97-211 in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on August 18, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
