

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, Tribal Member Franco Nosie, advises this Tribal Council that he has come before the Tribal Council this date for the Councils' approval to begin and operate a satellite communications business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nosie advises the Tribal Council that he will be the sole proprietor and that he will be doing business in Chinatown under the name "Apache Communications"; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves Mr. Nosie's request for approval to conduct his business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation under the name of "Apache Communications" and wishes him success in his new business.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Tribal Member Franco Nosie's request to conduct a satellite communications business from his home in Chinatown; it being understood by the Tribal Council that Mr. Nosie is the sole proprietor of said business and that the business will operate under the name "Apache Communications."

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of Eight for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
