

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Mary Drehobl, a non-Indian, currently resides in, and has a residential lease with the Tribe for Lot A-33 in the Hondah Homesites; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Drehobl's lease will expire on September 30, 1997; and

WHEREAS, for the past year, Mrs. Drehobl has offered her home for sale to any tribal member able to secure financing to purchase the home, but to date, has been unsuccessful in locating a suitable tribal member purchaser who qualifies for financing with any of the financial institutions who conduct business on the reservation; and

WHEREAS, tribal member, Gwendena Real Bird, by previous Resolution No. 08-97-266, was given permission to purchase this home from Mrs. Drehobl; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Real Bird is in the process of obtaining a HUD 184 guaranteed loan through Bank One, but may not be able to obtain the loan until after Mrs. Drehobl's lease expiration date; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Drehobl is requesting Tribal Council approval to extend her lease for a period of sixty (60) days in order to allow Mrs. Real Bird or any other tribal member the opportunity to purchase her home; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be granted to Mary Drehobl for a sixty (60) day extension of her existing lease for Lot A-33 in the Hondah Homesites.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to Mary Drehobl for a sixty (60) day extension of her existing residential lease with the Tribe for Hondah Homesites A-33.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that approval of this sixty (60) day extension is granted in order to allow a tribal member the opportunity to secure financing to purchase the home located on Lot A-33.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (e), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
