


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) has requested a temporary construction easement and a permanent roadway easement for improvements at the intersection of North SR 73 and the Diamond Creek subdivision; and
- WHEREAS**, the purpose of the BIA's request is to enlarge the turning radius of the roadway pavement where northbound SR 73 turns on to the parallel frontage road; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has been provided a diagram of the proposed construction easement and permanent roadway easement for said improvements; and
- WHEREAS**, the proposal will effect the existing lot on the corner of the frontage roadway presently assigned to Betty Gomez who has since transferred and sold her home to her brother Luke Williams and has also expressed an intention to transfer the land to her brother Luke Williams and that anything concerning the home and land be directed to Luke Williams for his decision; and
- WHEREAS**, Luke and Vivian Williams have come before the Tribal Council this date and requested that there be no encroachment on the Williams/Gomez land assignment during the intersection modification and the Tribal Council is agreeable to their request.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the BIA-ADOT request to complete the intersection modification at northbound SR 73 and Diamond Creek subdivision (approximate milepost 344.1) but directs that there be no encroachment on the Williams/Gomez land assignment and that BIA-ADOT complete its modification and intersection improvements without encroaching on the Williams/Gomez land assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on October 8, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a),(b),(e),(h), (i), (m), (n), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
