

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has heard from several Council Members that their Ford Taurus Tribal vehicles, provided to Tribal Council Members for official Tribal business, are experiencing maintenance problems; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands that an arrangement has been made with Hatch Motors of Show Low whereby five (5) Council vehicles would be accepted for trade-in and credited toward the purchase of new Toyota pickup trucks and Jeep Cherokees for five (5) council members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands that Council Members Romeo Dazen, Alvin Declay, Herbert Tate, Johnny Endfield, and Margaret Walker are the Council Members who will receive these new vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands that approximately seventy two thousand dollars (\$72,000) in cash, plus trade-in of the current Council vehicles, is required to purchase these new vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands that the Tribal Education Department is also in need of a new vehicle.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that seventy-two thousand dollars (\$72,000), plus the trade-in of five (5) Ford Tauruses, will be made available for the purchase of five (5) new vehicles for official use by Tribal Council Members Romeo Dazen, Alvin Declay, Herbert Tate, Johnny Endfield, and Margaret Walker.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) shall be appropriated for the purchase of a new vehicle for the Tribal Education Department, and that any remaining amount necessary for the purchase of that vehicle shall be provided out of the Education Department's own budget.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (b), (h), and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
