

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Janet Craig, a representative from the Carrizo Community has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request on behalf of the community to utilize land claim funds for a Christmas party and a trip to the Phoenix Zoo for children and residents of the community; and

WHEREAS, the community is requesting Five Thousand Dollars for the community Christmas party, where a dinner will be provided and each member will receive a gift; and

WHEREAS, the community is also requesting Two Thousand Dollars for a Zoo/Movie trip to Phoenix on December 27, 1997 and all school age children in the community will be invited; and

WHEREAS, the community also advises the council that its community building is in dire need of repairs and after the building is renovated the community would like to secure the building with a fence; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves the request.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the Carrizo Community to obtain Seven Thousand Dollars from the land claims fund for the purposes set forth in this resolution and in their November 20, 1997 letter to the Tribal Council, attached and incorporated by reference herein.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
