FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


**WHEREAS**, Tribal Member Lydia Martin has come before the Tribal Council and requested financial assistance to attend the John Casablancas Modeling and Career Center in Scottsdale, Arizona so that she can be better prepared to pursue employment in the modeling field; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council advises that the limit for assistance is Five Hundred Dollars.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes financial assistance in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars from the appropriate account to assist in the payment of Ms. Martin's tuition fees at the John Casablancas Modeling and Career Center.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
