RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution directed that a proposed revision to the Domestic Violence Code be posted for public comment as required by the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Council is advised that the office of the Tribal Council Secretary posted said proposed code on Friday, November 14, and Monday, November 17, 1997; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the proposed Domestic Violence ordinance be finally approved.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves, adopts and enacts the attached Domestic Violence Code effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 3, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
