

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, tribal member, Allison Hill, by previous Resolution No. 07-97-183, obtained Tribal Council permission to negotiate for the purchase of a home at Hondah Homesites; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 07-97-183 authorized a residential lease for Allison Hill contingent upon final completion of the sales transaction for the home, within ninety (90) days of the date of said resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the ninety days granted Ms. Hill has lapsed, and Ms. Hill is requesting Tribal Council approval for an extension to enable her to secure financing to purchase a home at Hondah Homesites.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends authorization to Allison Hill to enter into a lease and to encumber the premises located at Hondah Homesites Lot A-104, for the purpose of securing a loan with a financial institution through the HUD 184 Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that this extension shall be approved for an additional ninety (90) days from the date of this resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman, to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on December 16, 1997, adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (b), (e), (f), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
