- WHEREAS, Tribal member Marilou Colelay has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request for financial assistance to assist in the burial and awake for her mother, non-Tribal member Joanne Taylor recently deceased; and
- WHEREAS, Marilou Colelay Tribal member is the daughter of the deceased Joanne Taylor; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes assistance should be provided to the family and expresses its sympathy and prayers to the surviving family members..
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants death benefits assistance to the family of the deceased Joanne Taylor in the amount of Five Hundred dollars and a lumber donation from the Fort Apache Timber Company for the wake.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 16, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
