- WHEREAS, tribal member Beverly Fisher has come before the Tribal Council this date on behalf of her son Walter Begay Jr. and is accompanied by Mrs. Eleanor Hill, grandmother to Walter Begay Jr.; and
- WHEREAS, Beverly Fisher requests that the Tribal Council approve transfer of a home in McNary located on 110 First Street to Walter Begay Jr. as the house is presently titled to Walter Begay Jr.'s grandmother, Dorothy Begay, a non-member; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that all concerned consent to the transfer of title as title to the home cannot reside in a non-member and title must be in a Tribal member's name; and
- WHEREAS, Walter Begay Jr. age 21, will soon be getting married and needs a home for his family but his grandmother, Dorothy Begay, will remain in the home under his care.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves transfer of title to the McNary home located at 110 First Street to Walter Begay Jr. as requested by his mother Beverly Fisher, and his grandmother, Eleanor Hill.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 7, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
