

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 11-97-342 directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments to Section 2.28 of the Judicial Code, establishing a Disciplinary Committee, in each district for a minimum of 10 days as required by the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Council Secretary advised the Tribal Council that said proposed ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having received no opposition to the proposed amendments to Section 2.28 of the Judicial Code concludes that Ordinance No 212 amending the Judicial Code to establish a Disciplinary Committee should be enacted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 212 amending Section 2.28 of the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
