RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed budget for the Apache Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Council in reviewing the proposed budget has discussed with the General Manager, Gerald Alsenay the issues with which his enterprise is faced; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council wishes to approve the budget to assist in the continued smooth operation of the enterprise, provided that no salary increases will be approved at this time.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the budget for the Apache Enterprise, provided that no salary increases are approved at this time until the Central Tribal Budget is completed and reviewed.

The foregoing resolution was on June 1, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
