


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, two Tribal member high school students, Brandon and Jovanna Aday, were accepted into the Presidential Classroom Future World Leaders Summit to be held July 5-12, 1998 in Washington, D.C. and have come before the Tribal Council requesting financial assistance from the Tribe to attend the summit; and


WHEREAS, Tribal Council is agreeable to donating \$300 each to Brandon and Jovanna Aday for the purpose stated.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$600 from the Tribal Chairman's Public Relations Account to assist Brandon and Jovanna Aday, in the amount of \$300 each for their travel expenses to Washington, D.C. where they will attend the Presidential Classroom Future World Leaders Summit as representatives of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of seven for one against, and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
