RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, two Tribal member high school students, Jerome Kasey III and Taralyn Weeks, from the organization known as STRIVE (Students Together Rising in Vocational Education) are traveling to New Orleans, LA to participate in the National Future Homemakers of America (FHA) Conference, July 3 through July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the students have already paid \$300 each for the Conference deposit and registration, but they still need an additional \$700 per student and the deadline for final payment is May 20, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council based upon a review of the request and an examination of the merits concludes that students should be assisted with tribal funds but that such assistance should be available no more than one time during a one-year period.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$400 from the Tribal Chairman's Public Relations Account to assist these students in their travel expenses to New Orleans, LA where they will attend the National FHA Conference.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that assistance by the Tribal Council for the benefit of these two Tribal member's shall be made only once during a one-year period.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of six for, three against and one by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
