FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, a Tribal member, Reagan Armstrong Jr., was selected for a youth tour to Washington D.C. through Navopache Electric Coop., on June 11-19, 1998 and has come before the Tribal Council requesting for financial assistance from the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council is agreeable to donating \$300.00 for the purpose stated.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$300.00 from the Tribal Chairman's Public Relations Account to assist Reagan Armstrong Jr., for travel expenses to Washington, D.C.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
