RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has utilized the services of Robert Neuman to serve as a liaison between the Tribe and the federal legislative branch, executive branch, and departments and agencies in Washington, D.C.; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Neuman has been instrumental in advising the Tribe on legislative and policy issues in the nation's capital; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Neuman has proven to be useful in assisting the Tribe in making its views and interests known with the appropriate legislative and executive branch officials in Washington, D.C., as well as assisting the Tribe in other areas; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Neuman has asked for a renewal of the agreement to provide his services to the Tribe for a monthly fee of \$3,500 plus expenses; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes the value to the Tribe in obtaining and paying for such services.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a renewal of the services agreement between the Tribe and Mr. Robert Neuman.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, to enter into an agreement with Mr. Neuman pursuant to the terms set forth above.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 2, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against and <u>one</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
