

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Steve Owens, democrat candidate for the sixth United States Congressional District in Arizona has come before the Tribal Council to discuss his legislative goals and beliefs; and

**WHEREAS,** the sixth congressional district of Arizona includes reservation land of eight different Arizona Indian Tribes; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Owens has described the current "war on Indian tribes" occurring at this time in the nation's legislative body; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Owens has vowed to speak out for and defend the interests of Indian tribes, if elected; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council believes Mr. Owens is the candidate that is best qualified to speak for the interests of the sixth congressional district.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the candidacy of Steve Owens for the sixth district of Arizona to the United States Congress.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
