

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, tribal member Abel Burnette, Sr. has come before the Tribal Council this date and complained of his wrongful termination at the Hon-Dah Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Burnette explained the problems he encountered with Hon-Dah Management and the process which led to his being terminated; and

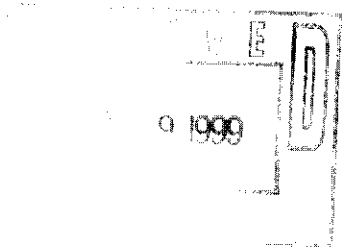
WHEREAS, Mr. Burnette requested that the Tribal Council reinstate him to his position as Housekeeping Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concurs that Mr. Abel Burnette, Sr. should be reinstated to his position as Housekeeping Supervisor at the Hon-Dah Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further recommends that Chairman Massey meet with Hondah Manager and Housekeeping staff to maintain a cordial working relationship among all staff.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reinstates Mr. Abel Burnette, Sr. to his position as Housekeeping Supervisor at Hondah and recommends that Chairman Massey meet with Hondah Manager and Housekeeping staff to assure cordial working relationship among all staff.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of nine for, zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
