- WHEREAS, Lorraine Jones, Navajo Tribal Member and a long time resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation passed away; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Jones, although not a member of this tribe, lived here for many years; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Lorraine Jones' grandchildren are enrolled members of the White Mountain Apache tribe; and
- WHEREAS, it is the request of the family that Mrs. Lorraine Jones' body be buried in McNary, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, because of the extensive and long-term relationship Mrs. Jones had with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Council wishes to honor this final request for Lorraine Jones.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the family's request for burial of the body of Mrs. Lorraine Jones at McNary.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 13, 1998</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
