

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Attorney has advised the Tribal Council that Cheryl Martin is serving as Acting Tribal Prosecutor; and

**WHEREAS,** Mrs. Martin is serving in that position on a temporary basis to help restore the functions of the Prosecution Unit; and

**WHEREAS,** Mrs. Martin is providing her services to the Tribe at a rate of \$110.00 per hour up to thirty hours per week; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Attorney recommends that a contract be approved by the Council setting forth the terms for the temporary position; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has reviewed the contract set forth herein.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a temporary employment contract for up to sixty days for Cheryl Martin as Acting Tribal Prosecutor.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby delegates authority to the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, to execute any documents needed to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 1, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (d), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
