FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Ramona Quihuiz and Joan Smith with Arizona Department of Health Services have come before the Tribal Council this date with information on their program; and

WHEREAS, the program (Well Woman Healthcheck Program) provides breast and cervical cancer screening through Indian Health Service (IHS); and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the need for such services is needed on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and endorses the Well Woman Healthcheck Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses the Well Woman Healthcheck Program and the services they provide.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (r), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
