RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Alvin Thompson has come before the Tribal Council to seek assistance in resolving a job related injury he received four years ago; and
- **WHEREAS,** Mr. Thompson has many unanswered questions concerning the status of a worker's compensation claim he filed as well as the status of medical reports and records which he has requested; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Thompson reports that this important issue has never been resolved; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council intends to see that this Tribal member is provided all remedies to which he is entitled for his injury.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Tribal Legal Department to assist Mr. Alvin Thompson in obtaining answers and resolution to the injury claims for his work related injury.

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
