

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Whiteriver Police Department needs additional office space; and


WHEREAS, the old BIA Superintendent house is vacant and the Whiteriver Police Department request the use of this building for office space; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that this home has a parking garage located behind it and tribal member, Gerald Riley, is homeless and requests the use of the garage for living quarters for himself.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to the Whiteriver Police Department to utilize the old BIA Superintendent home as additional office space.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to Gerald Riley to inhabit the parking garage behind the Old Superintendent house as his living quarters.

The foregoing resolution was on October 8, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
