RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has met this day with the Tribal Education Department to review the Tribal Scholarship Program for eligible Tribal members enrolled in post-secondary education; and
- WHEREAS, the Council has been advised by the Director of the Tribal Education Program, Linda Declay, that the previous scholarship levels established in Resolution 08-98-195A could jeopardize the need based scholarships and loans held by Tribal members currently enrolled in a post-secondary education program; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Higher Education Director recommends modifications to the standards set forth in the prior resolution.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby implements the following scholarship levels for eligible Tribal members attending college or university.

Freshmen Level	\$2,500 per semester
Sophomore Level	\$3,000 per semester \$3,000 per semester
Junior Level	
Senior Level	\$3,500 per semester
Graduate Student	\$5,000 per semester

In addition, a travel allowance of \$500 per semester shall be provided for eligible Tribal member students residing within the reservation who attend school full time out of state.

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Director of the Tribal Education Department and the Indian Education Committee to continue to work on eligibility standards to promote incentives for academic performance by Tribal member students, and to report back to the Tribal Council with further modification to the scholarship program effective for the spring semester.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that prior Resolution 08-98-195A is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on October 19, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
