**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company annually provides Christmas bonuses to FATCO employees each December; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received many concerns from tribal members regarding said bonuses; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that bonuses are deserved and should be provided.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Tribal Chairman Massey to seek funding to pay Christmas bonuses for the FATCO employees.

The foregoing resolution was on December 22, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
