



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS**, Tribal member Gertie Lupe has come before the Tribal Council to report that Pastor Roy Sullivan, of the Assembly of God church in McNary, passed away yesterday evening; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council expresses its sympathy to the family and congregation of Pastor Sullivan; and
- WHEREAS**, Pastor Sullivan has served as a minister on this reservation for 23 years, including his final 16 years at the Assembly of God church in McNary; and
- WHEREAS**, Pastor Sullivan had requested that he and his wife be allowed grave sites in McNary; and
- WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council wishes to honor this request in gratitude and recognition of Pastor Sullivan years of service in the ministry within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends its sincere sympathies to the family and church congregation on the passing of Pastor Roy Sullivan of the McNary Assembly of God Church.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it grants a grave site for the remains of Pastor Sullivan and reserves a companion site for Mrs. Sullivan when needed.

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
