RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member, Sylvia Browning informed the Tribal Council that she has been accepted into the Washington Internship for Native Students (WINS) Program as an Intern for the 1999 program year; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Browning advised the Tribal Council that she will be representing Native Americans and working in a professional environment which requires an appropriate wardrobe; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Browning has requested financial assistance from the Tribe to purchase the appropriate clothing; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council believes that this is a worthwhile endeavor and concurs that this request should be granted.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes financial assistance in the amount of \$500.00 to Sylvia Browning to purchase professional wardrobe for participation in the WINS program.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Ms. Browning may seek other funding from Tribal Education and Social Services as needed.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
