FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

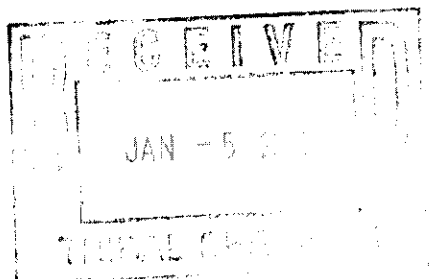
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the status of Youth Camps; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council were informed that the Youth Camps are in need of repairs; and


WHEREAS, Tribal Education Department will coordinate day camps this year and provide stipends for the camper's attendance while the Youth Camps are being renovated.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves day camp with stipend payments for the youth while Youth Camps are being renovated.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ONE against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
