RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs maintains a listing of all roads on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for which they have a responsibility which is referred to as the BIA Roads System; and
- WHEREAS, road mileage on the BIA Roads System is used in the formula for funding of road maintenance and construction monies; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to update this list from time to time to insure that the Tribe receives its full entitlement to these monies.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached proposed addition of roads to the BIA Roads System.

The foregoing resolution was on May 18, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
