

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, Tribal member Roger Griggs, Sr. informed the Tribal Council that he will be completing Medical School soon and will begin his Residency training in July at the University Medical Center in Tucson, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Griggs is requesting further financial assistance as he will have no means of financial support for the months of May through July, 1999; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council acknowledges Mr. Griggs efforts in completing Medical School and supports his request for financial assistance in the amount of \$2,000.00 per month for the three months identified, plus, an additional \$1,130.00 for expenses.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Mr. Griggs' request for financial assistance in the amount of \$2,000.00 per month for three months, plus and additional \$1,130.00 for extra expenses, for a total of \$7,130.00 to be paid over the three month period.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1933 (48 Stat. 984).
