

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal member, Arlinda M. Cassa has come before the Council this day to ask for assistance in locating a home for her and her children; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cassa informed the Council that her and her family are presently living in overcrowded conditions; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Cassa further requested assistance to have ex-husband prohibited from the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Housing Authority to locate emergency housing for Arlinda M. Cassa and her family.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Attorney is to meet with Ms. Cassa to review the potential for seeking an exclusion order against her ex-husband.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
