FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**



WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after review of the Land Board meeting minutes, discussed concerns regarding Hondah business sites, relinquishments and deceased land assignments; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement that the Land Board meeting minutes of February 9, March 26, April 30, and May 3, 1999 should be approved.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Land Board meeting minutes of February 9, March 26, April 30, and May 3, 1999 as presented.

The foregoing resolution was on May 6, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

The Regularly scheduled Land Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, February 09, 1999, in the Executive Conference.
