

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division has presented recommendations for the 1999 - 2000 Tribal Member Hunting Regulations, and in developing these recommendations, has solicited tribal member input through various community meetings; and

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations call for a limited number of permits for white-tail and mule deer which will be issued by draw and by hunting zone; and further calls for an increase in the cost of white-tail permits, as well as a waiting period for draw eligibility of one year for white-tail and two years for mule deer; and

WHEREAS, all general elk permits shall be issued by hunting zone, and beginning in 1999 will institute a draw eligibility waiting period of one year for General Bull Elk and two years for Unit 8 Trophy Elk; and

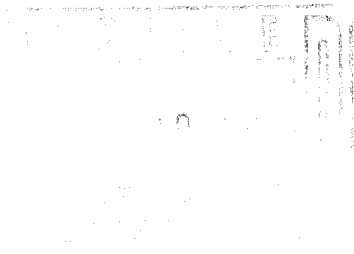
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has recommended doubling the number of Unit 8 Trophy Elk permits and to further increase the cost of General Bull and Unit 8 Trophy permits by \$25.00; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has recommended extending the fall turkey hunt by two weeks and to further institute a five year eligibility waiting period for pronghorn.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approves that it hereby approves the 1999 - 2000 Tribal Member Hunting Regulations as presented and as amended.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests that the Wildlife & Outdoor Recreation Division explore the possibility of marketing live elk and to investigate and analyze current tribal member bear harvest strategies.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
