

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Gary Alchesay of Tribal I.D. Herd has come before the Tribal Council this date and informed the Council of the need for more pasture for cattle; and

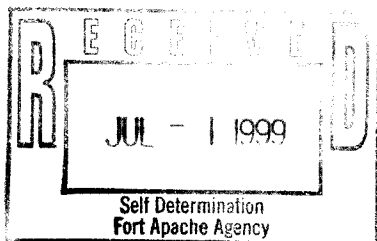
WHEREAS, Mr. Alchesay has requested the pasture near the Sunrise Ski Area, which consists of 7,133 acres and which has not been in use for two years; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Alchesay further requests burning of several cienegas to assist in restoration efforts; and


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Tribe that it hereby approves Mr. Alchesay's pasture request and the burning project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Mr. Alchesay to consult with and coordinated this project with the BIA, Tribal Watershed Planner Jonathan Long, and Tribal Forester Robert Lacapa.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for, ONE against and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
