## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary, Cyndy Harvey-Burnette, pursuant to Tribal Ordinance Number 59, recommends to the Tribal Council that Steven L. Moody, DOB: 07/08/80 who applied for membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe be accepted as a member; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council Secretary advises that Steven Lyle Moody qualifies for membership pursuant to the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee reviewed his application and recommends that he be granted enrollment into the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has reviewed the application and concurs with the recommendations of the Enrollment Committee that Steven Lyle Moody be granted membership status.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the applicant, Steven Lyle Moody, enrollment into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, subject to recision pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202(a) and 1-704.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 02, 1999</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 1, 2 and 3 of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
