RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Pastor Reno Johnson, Sr. of the Canyon Day Family Lighthouse Church has requested land in lower Canyon Day near the river for their annual camp meetings; and
- WHEREAS, the present camp meeting site is small and a larger site is needed as in the future Mr. Johnson plans to add bathroom and shower facilities to prepare for the future growth of his congregation; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council supports Pastor Johnson in his request to benefit tribal members and his ministry.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Land Board to approve the area of land that Pastor Johnson has requested.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 15, 1999</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (e) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30,1 993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
