RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Election Commission Chairperson, Curtis Suttle, has informed the Tribal Council of the need to increase the Election budget; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Suttle stated that the current budgeted amount of \$22,400 is insufficient as prior budgeted amount is usually in excess of \$50,000; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Suttle requests an increased budget amendment in the amount of \$28,600 for a total of \$51,000 for the Election budget.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a budget amendment in the amount of \$28,600 for the Election budget.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 13, 1999</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1933 (48 Stat. 984).
