

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council in prior Resolution 05-99-109 directed an investigation into the judicial conduct of Chief Judge Marjorie Grimes; and

**WHEREAS,** during the term of the investigation the Tribal Council directed that Judge Grimes be placed on administrative leave with pay; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has advised that the investigation has been completed and that the Tribe is awaiting the final report from the independent evaluator; and

**WHEREAS,** Tribal Council has been informed that with the absence created by the administrative leave of Judge Grimes the remaining Tribal Court judges have been faced with an burdensome case load; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that Judge Grimes should be put back in office pending the receipt and final review by the Council of independent evaluator's report, and a final determination by the Council will be made at that time.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that because the investigation phase has been completed the Honorable Chief Judge Marjorie Grimes is hereby reinstated to active duty in position in the Tribal Court pending review and final determination by the Tribal Council of the independent evaluator's report.

The foregoing resolution was on August 13, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for, TWO against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
