## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on this date heard a briefing from Center for Native American Health concerning their study completed on the cardiovascular health of firefighters who are members of the Fort Apache Hotshots; and
- WHEREAS, this group was selected for study by the Center as a representative group who would be presumed to have high levels of activity and physical fitness; and
- WHEREAS, the Center would like to share the results of their study in an upcoming meeting of the American Heart Association; and
- WHEREAS, upon discussion with the Council the Center has agreed that it would not publish the findings nor would the findings be distributed or discussed in a larger context other than at the meeting of concerned individuals at the American Heart Association.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the representatives from the Center for Native American Health to share their findings at the upcoming American Heart Association meeting concerning their study of the cardiovascular health of the Fort Apache Hotshots who participated in their study.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the permission granted herein is not include permission to publish the findings nor to provide the results with a broader audience than described above.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 1, 1999</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
