## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, convening on October 13, 1999 for Tribal Member requests, received Leo Thompson Jr.'s request for a small business license to operate a full service hair and beauty salon; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for small business enterprises within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation which provide essential services to residents of the Reservation to reduce the amount of travel, expense and even discrimination that Tribal members must incur by going off of the Reservation to obtain these services.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it directs the Tribal Treasurer to issue a small business license to Leo Thompson, Jr for the purposes of operating a full service hair and beauty salon that will service residents of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on October 13, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (j), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
