

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, convening on October 13, 1999 for Tribal Member requests, heard from Trudy Fall on her request for assistance with obtaining housing for her family and on her complaint about the administration of housing accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council does not have enough information to determine whether the Tribal Housing Authority account administration procedures caused Trudy Fall difficulty in qualifying for tribal housing.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it directs the Tribal Housing Authority to consider Trudy Fall as an alternate for qualified housing applicants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Housing Authority to reevaluate its administration of housing accounts, report any problems or errors to the Tribal Council, and correct all errors which could wrongfully prevent qualified tribal members from receiving consideration for housing assistance.

The foregoing resolution was on October 13, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (j), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
