

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Director, with recommendations from the Indian Education Committee, has proposed Higher Education scholarship modifications with consideration given to the current financial scholarship allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement with the proposed Higher Education scholarship modifications as presented.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby implements the following scholarship levels for eligible Tribal members attending colleges or universities as approved by the Indian Education Committee:

Approved Amounts:	Freshmen	\$2500 per semester
	Sophomore	\$2700 per semester
	Junior	\$3000 per semester
	Senior	\$3100 per semester
	Graduate	\$4500 per semester

Stipulations:

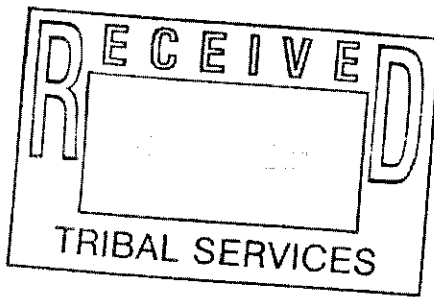
1. Freshmen: (1-29 earned credits)
Sophomore: (30-59 earned credits)
Junior: (48 credits from graduation in accordance with degree contract)
Senior: (24 credits from graduation in accordance with degree contract)
*Degree Contract - (aka program of study, must be current and signed by an advisor)
2. Jrs/Srs must participate as mentors for other beginning White Mountain Apache Scholars
3. Seniors must complete a graduation check/review.
4. Graduate students must commit to a service pledge.
5. Disbursal: Freshmen/Sophomore - Receive 50% of grant at mid-term.
Juniors/Seniors - Receive increase at mid-term (after submitting an updated degree contract and mid-term progress report, must be in good academic standing)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Director of the Tribal Education Department, Higher Education



Coordinator, Scholarship Review Committee, and Indian Education Committee to continue to work on updating the policies and procedures of the scholarship program and to report back to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1999 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
