

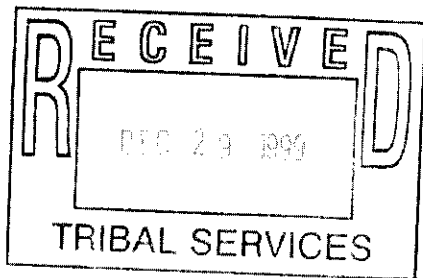
**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and the Law and Order Committee have thoroughly reviewed the proposed revisions to the Criminal Code, amending Chapters One and Two; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that said proposed amendments to the Criminal code, attached hereto as Ordinance No. 218, be posted for public comment as required by the Constitution.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments to Chapter One and Two of the Criminal Code in each District for ten days as required by the Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1999, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q) and (t) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
