

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**



**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to encourage the promotion and advertisement of hunting, fishing and other outdoor recreation opportunities available on the reservation; and

**WHEREAS**, the W&ORD desires to promote the Tribe's recreational opportunities, including the Spring Gobbler Hunt, through any means that are practical and cost-effective, that will present the Tribe's hunting program in a positive manner, while also highlighting the Tribe's cultural and traditional values as well as its natural resources; and

**WHEREAS**, a proposal has been presented to the White Mountain Apache Tribe by Primos, Inc., to obtain approval to video a turkey hunting segment on the reservation during the 2000 Spring gobbler season and in doing so, would assist the W&ORD in further promoting this and other hunting opportunities that are available on the reservation; and

**WHEREAS**, Primos, Inc., would purchase two spring gobbler hunts, and would accordingly provide hunters and a filming crew during the hunt, while also featuring a Tribal guide in the video; and

**WHEREAS**, Primos, Inc., would incur all related costs to produce the video; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has directed W&ORD staff to negotiate a percentage of revenues for the Tribe for the sale of the video cassettes.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with a proposal from Primos, Inc., seeking approval to produce a Spring gobbler hunting segment during the 2000 hunting season on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.

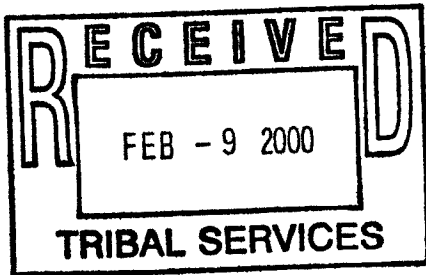
**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this video will assist the W&ORD in promoting the Tribe's Spring gobbler and other hunting opportunities available on the reservation, while expanding the client market.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants permission to Primos, Inc., to produce its turkey hunting segment on the reservation and shall be contingent on the development of an



appropriate agreement contract between the Tribe and Primos, Inc., that outlines their commitments and protects Tribal interest.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and THREE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
