

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, by virtue of the powers listed in the Tribal Constitution and the Tribal Council's inherent authority to monitor all enterprises of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Phil Stago, Jr., as former Director of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division (WORD) conducted activities from an office at the department and had personal affects therein; and

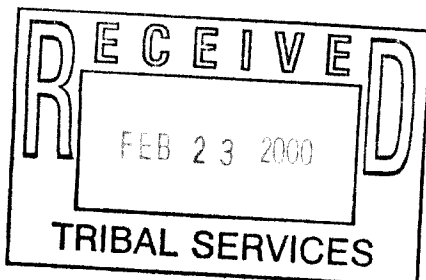
WHEREAS, Phil Stago, Jr. advised the Council that he had the following trophy animal mounts at WORD:


1. One should mount of a Canadian Moose
2. One Mountain Lion mounted on wood
3. One large Canadian Timber Wolf, blue-gray in color
4. One large Mule Deer mount
5. Two Canadian Geese mounts
6. Two Apache Trout mounted on wood; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that an employees personal affects which they bring to their place of employment remain the property of that employee when they leave their employment.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the WORD to return the above listed trophy animal mounts to Phil Stago, Jr., at a mutually convenient time and place.

The foregoing resolution was on ~~January 9, 2000~~ ^{February} January 9, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for, ZERO against, and ONE abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
