- WHEREAS, the Transportation Coordinator and the Roads Committee Chairperson have informed the Tribal Council of Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT's) failure to honor Resolution No. 01-2000- 15 (Hagan Hill easement); and
- WHEREAS, they recommend that it would be in the Tribe's best interest to rescind Resolution No. 02-2000-46 and follow up with ADOT for further action.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby concurs with the recommendation to rescind Resolution No. 02-2000-46.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 18, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
