

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Native Vision Program, with the consent of the Tribe, is planning an event for youth entitled *The Native Vision Sports and Life Skills Camp 2000* on June 9, 10, and 11, 2000 at Fort Apache; and

WHEREAS, the goals of this program are to enhance self-esteem for youth and provide positive group experiences and life skills training and education; and

WHEREAS, many of the events will include use of facilities of the Theodore Roosevelt School, including the dorm rooms and cafeteria; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that many youth from within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and other Indian communities in the Southwest will attend this important retreat; and

WHEREAS, many professional and collegiate athletes will come to the event to volunteer their time for youth; and

WHEREAS, involvement and support from many groups within our community are essential to the success of this event; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports the goals of this event of promoting "healthy minds, healthy bodies and healthy families"; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council in recognition of the value of this event for youth would like to see the participation and strong support from the Theodore Roosevelt School.

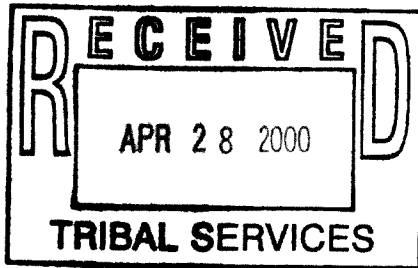
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the three day *Native Vision Sports and Life Skills Camp 2000* youth event by Native Vision at Fort Apache, and including the Theodore Roosevelt school facilities at Fort Apache.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Theodore Roosevelt School Board, school staff and students to make every effort in making facilities available for the event and providing any available assistance it can in preparation for and during the time of the three day youth event.


