RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-98-114 established a policy that Tribal enterprises and other Reservation based business be given the opportunity to meet any bid from outside vendors for materials needed in building and road work repair and construction, provided that the quality of the materials is comparable and that the Tribal enterprise or other Reservation based vendor can meet the contractor's supply schedule and specifications; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that this policy has proven detrimental to Tribal enterprises because it prohibits fair market value pricing on Reservation construction projects; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that this policy does not support the Tribe's effort to market reservation materials and should be rescinded.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution No.05-98-114 in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 31, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
